Addendum for Short Resettlement Plan (ICB-06B)

Tranche - 1

April 2015

Background

1. The addendum is prepared to incorporate the changes came in the original SRP ICB 06B, approved by ADB. ICB 06B comprises distributaries and minors off take from 10-R branch of LBDC main canal of Khanewal irrigation division. During the implementation of civil work, different options were explored to minimize the impact of resettlement of the sub-project. In original SRP ICB 06B only one Affected Person (AP) was expected to be impacted due to civil work implementation. But the implementation of civil work at the particular site is executed during canal closure period and consequently the AP was avoided from sub0project impact.
2. All the civil works activities are confined within existing right of way (ROW) of distributaries and minors. The ROW ranges from 35 to 45 feet and is owned by the Punjab Irrigation Department (PID), Government of Punjab. The ICB-06B requires temporary occupation of land for diversion works. All the proposed civil work activities are kept within the Col. Whereas, all necessary steps are taken to avoid the disturbance and displacement of the occupants.

Objectives of Addendum to RP

3. The addendum to ICB-06B is develop with the following objectives:
 - To incorporate the changes made in the approved ICB 06B
 - To compare the original and present list of AFs, impacts, costs and allowances

Scope of Land Acquisition & Affected Person (AP)

4. No permanent or temporary land has been acquired during the execution of the civil work of the sub-project.
5. The sub-project involves construction of diversion channels at 16 different locations. At RD 85 of 10R branch canal, private land was required for diversion channel according the approved SRP ICB 06B.
6. The civil work at RD 85 of 10R branch canal was executed during canal closure period therefore AP (Ghulam Hussain S/O Sher Muhammad was avoided from the impact of the sub-project. Mr. Ghulam Hussain S/O Sher Muhammad was contacted to take his view point whether he has been impacted or not. He has confirmed that his land was not acquired for the execution of civil work.

Impacts on Women Headed Households

7. No woman headed households is impacted during the implementation of ICB-06B.

Impacts on Govt. Trees

8. There is no govt. tree is being impacted during the execution of the civil work of the sub-project.
